

Kum. Devaki Rajendran has shown talent for dancing since childhood. She was initiated into formal dancing by Sri Sreekantan Nair, the then dance teacher at Bharatiya Vidya Bhavan, Kumarapuram, where she studied till fourth standard. She moved to Mumbai in 2000, where she continued her training in Bharatanatyam under Smt. Mayuri Kharat for the next six years.

On her return to Thiruvananthapuram, she joined Regatta Cultural Society to continue her training under Smt. Girija Chandran. At Regatta she was introduced to Mohiniyattam and Kuchipudi under Smt. Shobha Mohandas and Smt.Bijula Balakrishnan respectively. However, having had longer training in Bharatanatyam and showing a greater propensity towards the form, Smt. Girija Chandran provided a much needed influence to develop her own style of dancing.

Devaki has been successful in her academics, despite her commitment to dancing. She holds a Post Graduate degree in Music from HH Maharaja's College for Women, Thiruvananthapuram; and has ranked first in the University of Kerala at both the undergraduate and post graduate levels. Blessed with teachers who have been understanding and encouraging of her diverse interests and talents, she has been able to secure several awards at the university level. She is also a B-Grade rtist in Bharatanatyam at Doordarshan, Thiruvananthapuram.

her interests and passion for the stage has now led to the theatre circuits, where she has had success with her dramatic performances. She has worked closely with theatre associations like Kanal Samskarika Vedi and APT, through four plays,
